Dear Reader:

Thank you for your investment of time and interest in the information contained on the Kern Regional Center website and specifically in the following report. At KRC and throughout the Regional Center system, we are committed to assuring support to all individuals who are entitled to services under the Lanterman Act.

The data you will be reviewing in this report has been provided to KRC and offers a glance of our assurance of this commitment but like all data-driven reports <u>please be aware of the potential</u> <u>short-falls of data collection and reporting parameters.</u>

- We recognize that some individuals served have multiple qualifying conditions that may require additional service authorization. This characteristic of the data is not fully incorporated into this report and as a result individuals referenced with more than one qualifying condition will show the allocation amounts inclusive of all conditions not just the primary diagnosis in the data overview. This may skew the data in terms of funding for specific diagnostic areas.
- Information on **individual choice**, **family or cultural values** are not defined or in the data report but make an important contribution to the actual <u>utilization</u> of services. We fully respect client choice, family and cultural values that may impact decisions reached by the IPP/IFSP team and/or the family as it relates to use of services authorized and this is not reflected in the data-report. The report indicates the amount of the allocation authorized or encumbered by KRC under the heading 'total authorized services.' KRC authorizes services based on the IPP/IFSP but families or individuals are not obligated to utilize the full allocation and they determine this utilization based on a variety of reasons. You will note the amount of resource referenced in 'total expenditures' column in the report. This is the allocation actually utilized by the family or individual for their support purchases.
- We recognize that Kern Regional Center has a substantial geographic catchment area.
 We note that some geographic areas have a non-traditional service design under the Self-Determination-Pilot which is not carved out in the data report you will be reviewing.
 This data is impactful both in the Purchase of Service (POS) and number of individuals served under each qualifying condition, age and ethnic representation.
- Routinely, clients discontinue services for a variety of reasons and the 'point in time' data sort does not fully include all of those occurrences as the process of notification in the system does not fully match up with the release of the report. When an individual discontinues a service for any reason, the data may continue to be represented in the number of individuals served, characteristics of that individual (diagnosis, age and ethnic background) and the encumbrance and actual expense categories. Additionally, when new clients enter the system, their personal characteristics (diagnosis, ethnic background and age) and Purchase of Service (POS) data may not be fully installed into the system at the time the data was released to sufficiently be reflected in this report.

• We are all committed to transparency and timely disclosure and we believe a deeper analysis from the data provided and contained in this report will need to be performed to more fully understand any issues associated with any potential disparity of actual expenditure based on defined criteria. We also recognize that this is a valuable conversation and the data should guide and inform us of areas we need to examine in order to more effectively serve all of the individuals throughout our catchment area.

All of this acknowledged, KRC is confident in our effort to assure active engagement with all clients and families we serve and we are committed to move forward in our efforts to meet the needs of all individuals through their IPP/IFSP informed service. We are working to engage with all clients represented in the Kern Regional Center catchment area and look forward to any observations and comments you have regarding this report at a public meeting to be held early 2014. Please keep an eye on the KRC website for additional announcements on dates and location for this important discussion.
